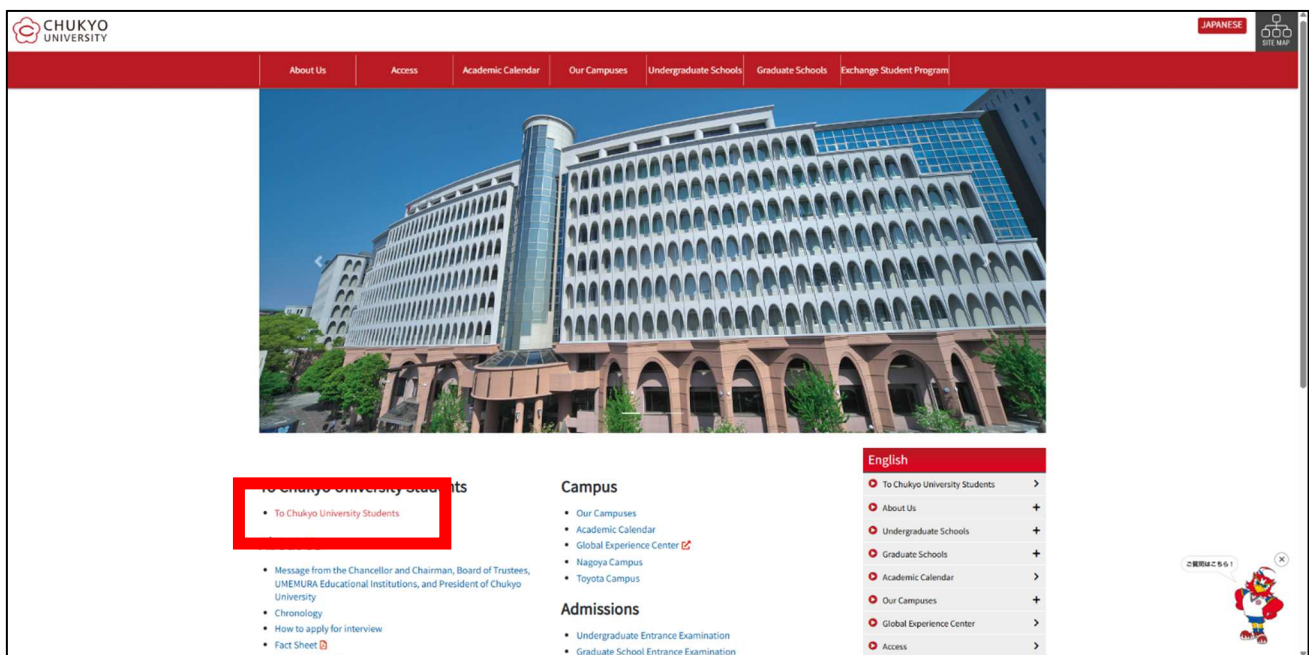

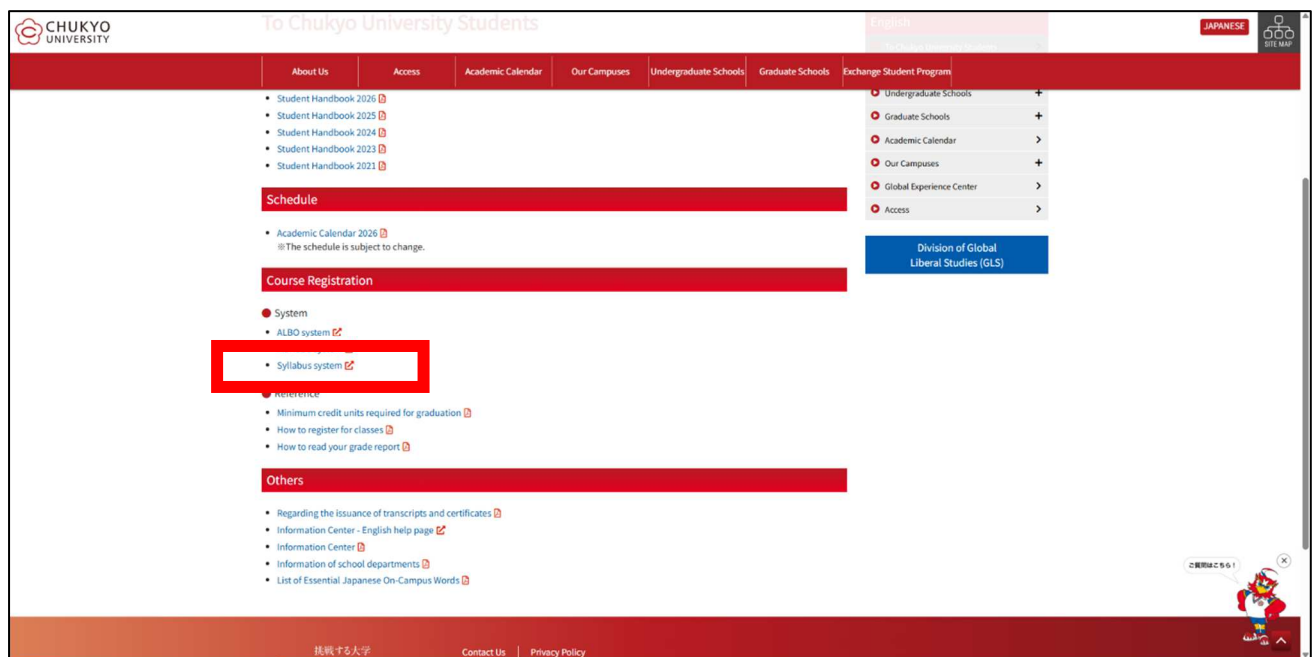
Step2. Click "English".
